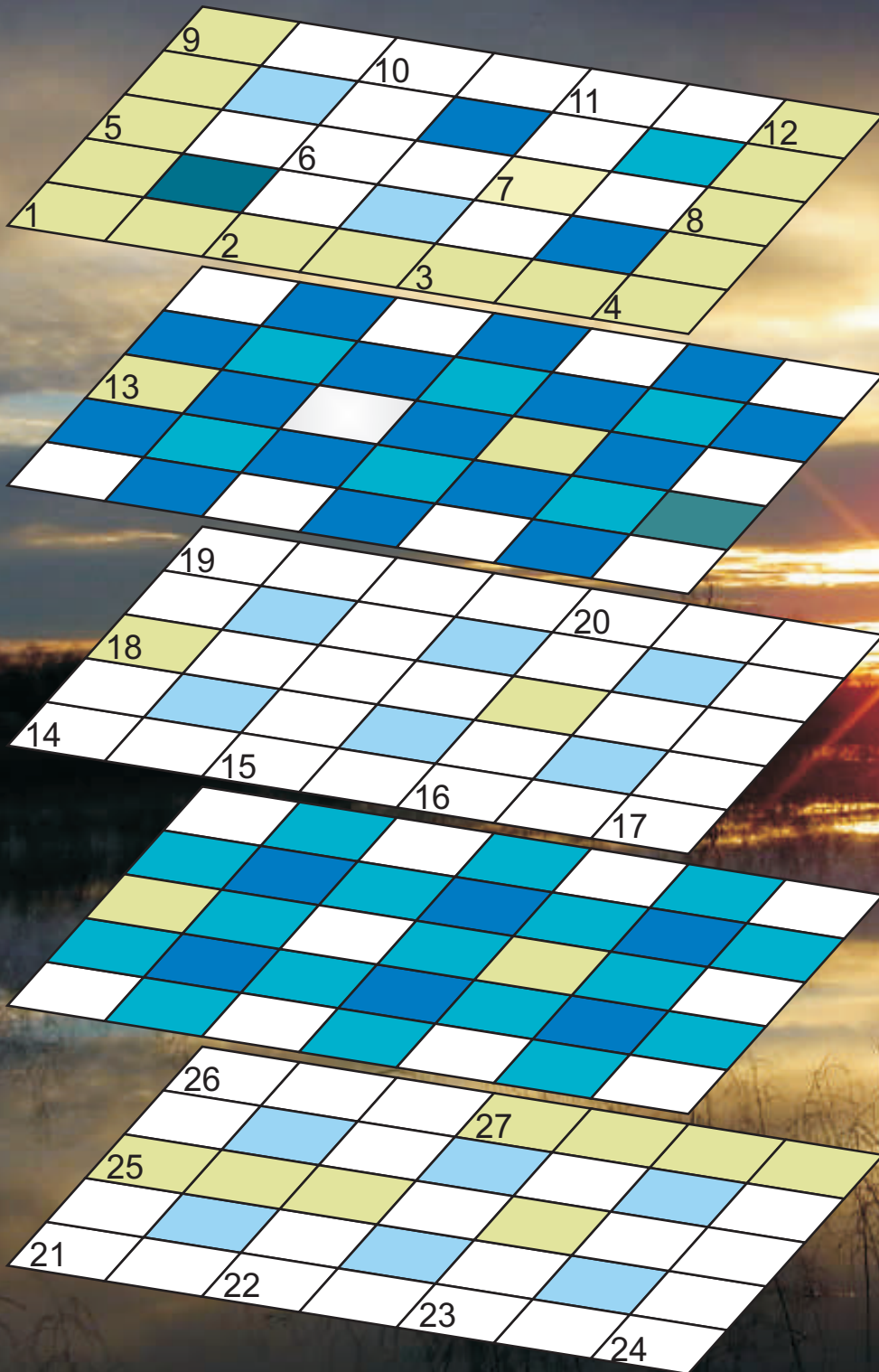


# MAY 2011 Pasquale
