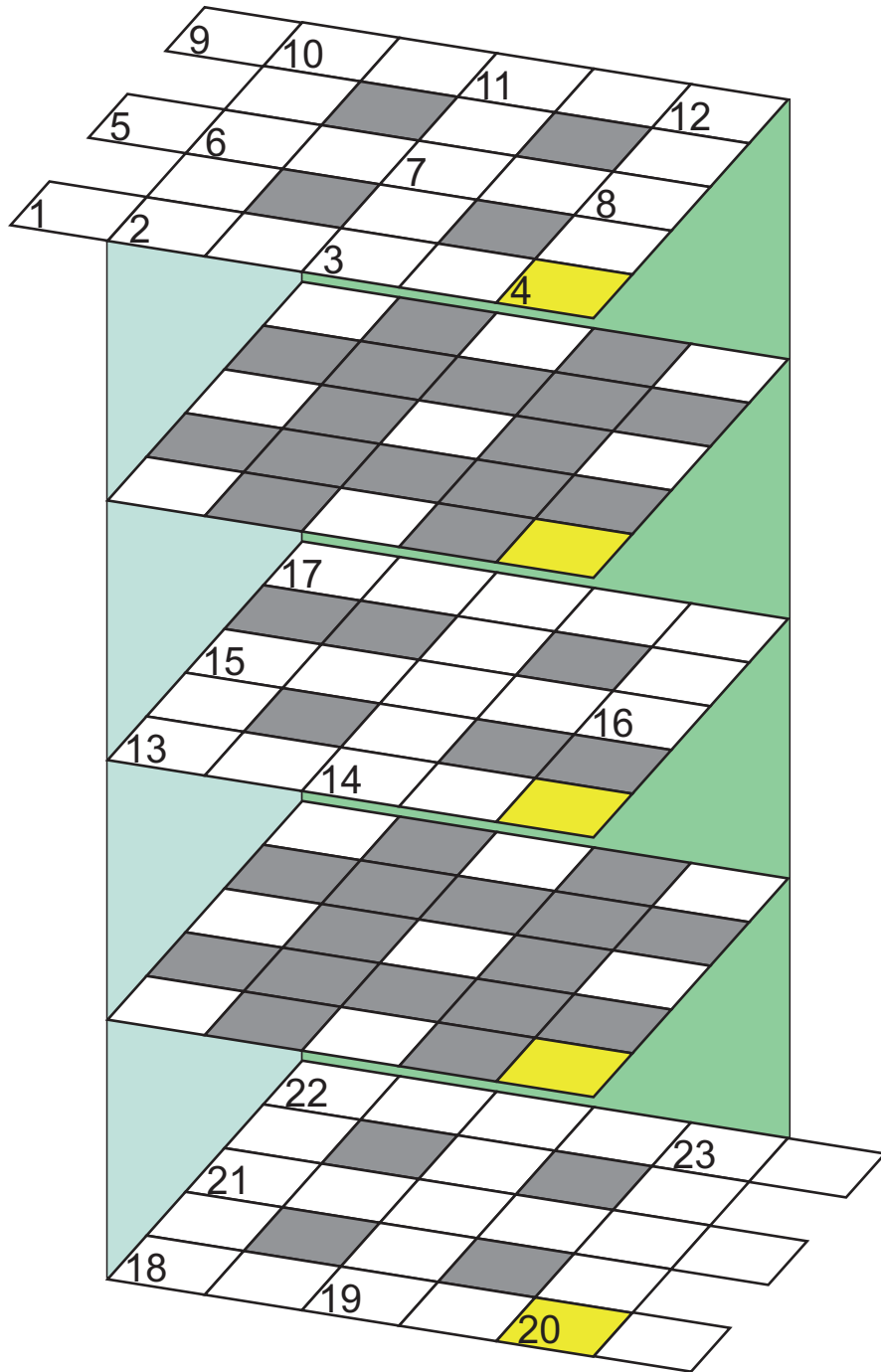


# Sirius April Extra 2012

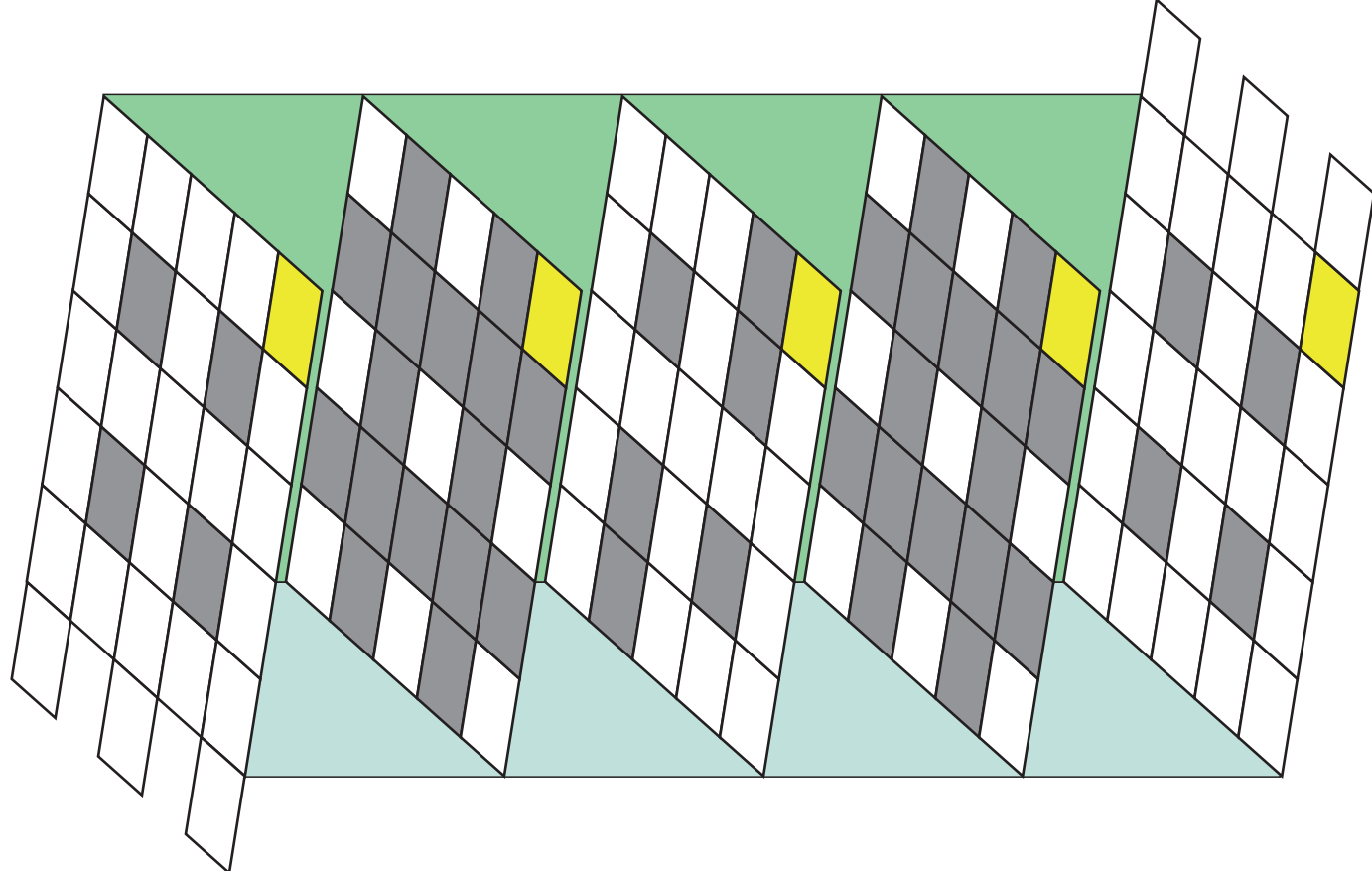
The colours and highlights in the grid are there to help the eye, particularly with down solutions.
