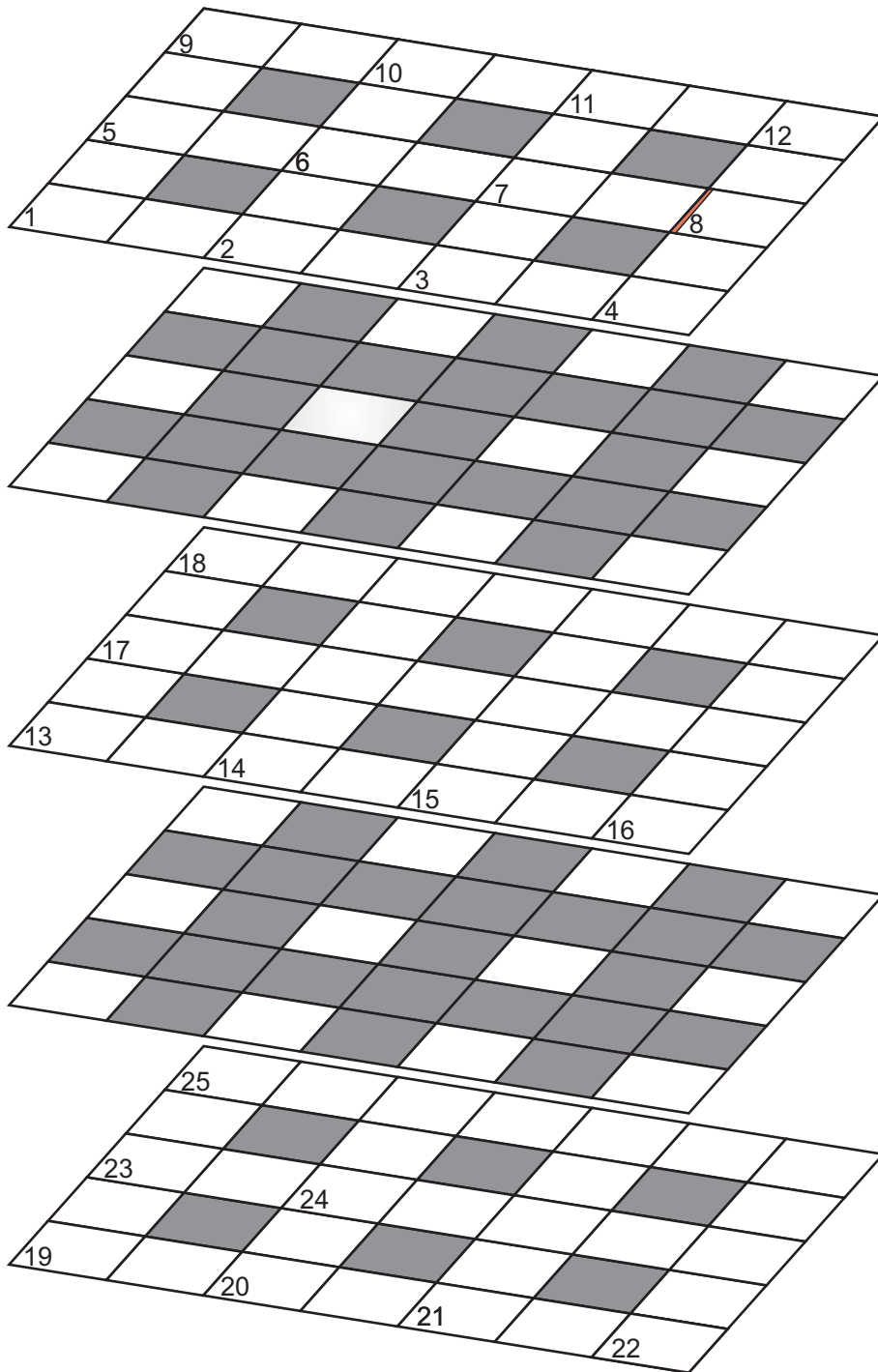


June Extra 2012 Sirius
