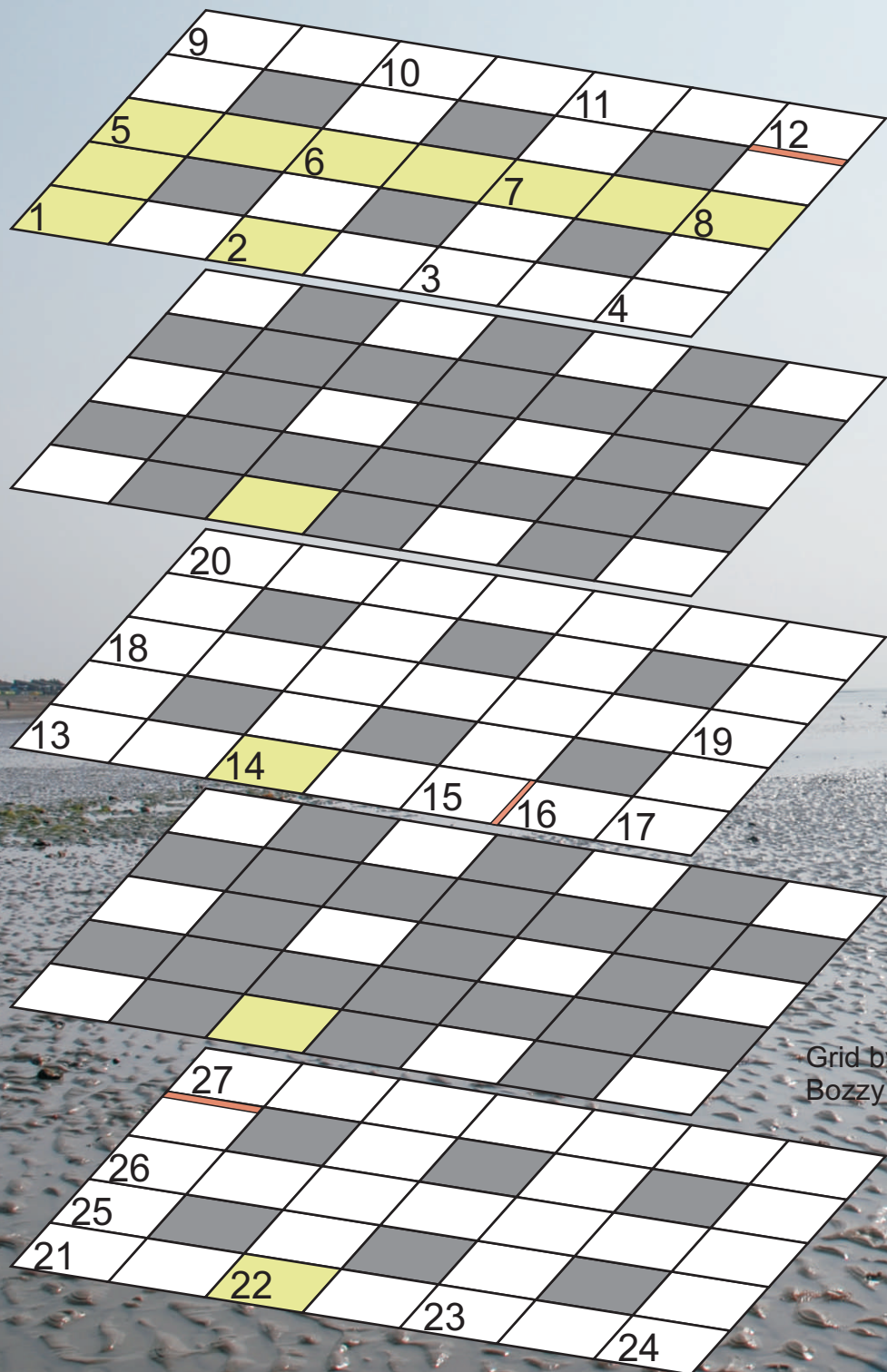


# May 2012 Locum
