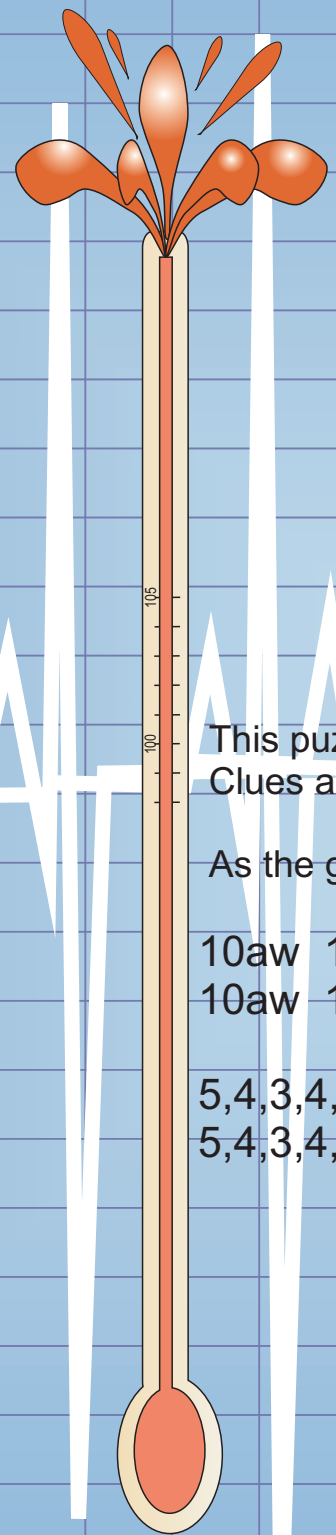
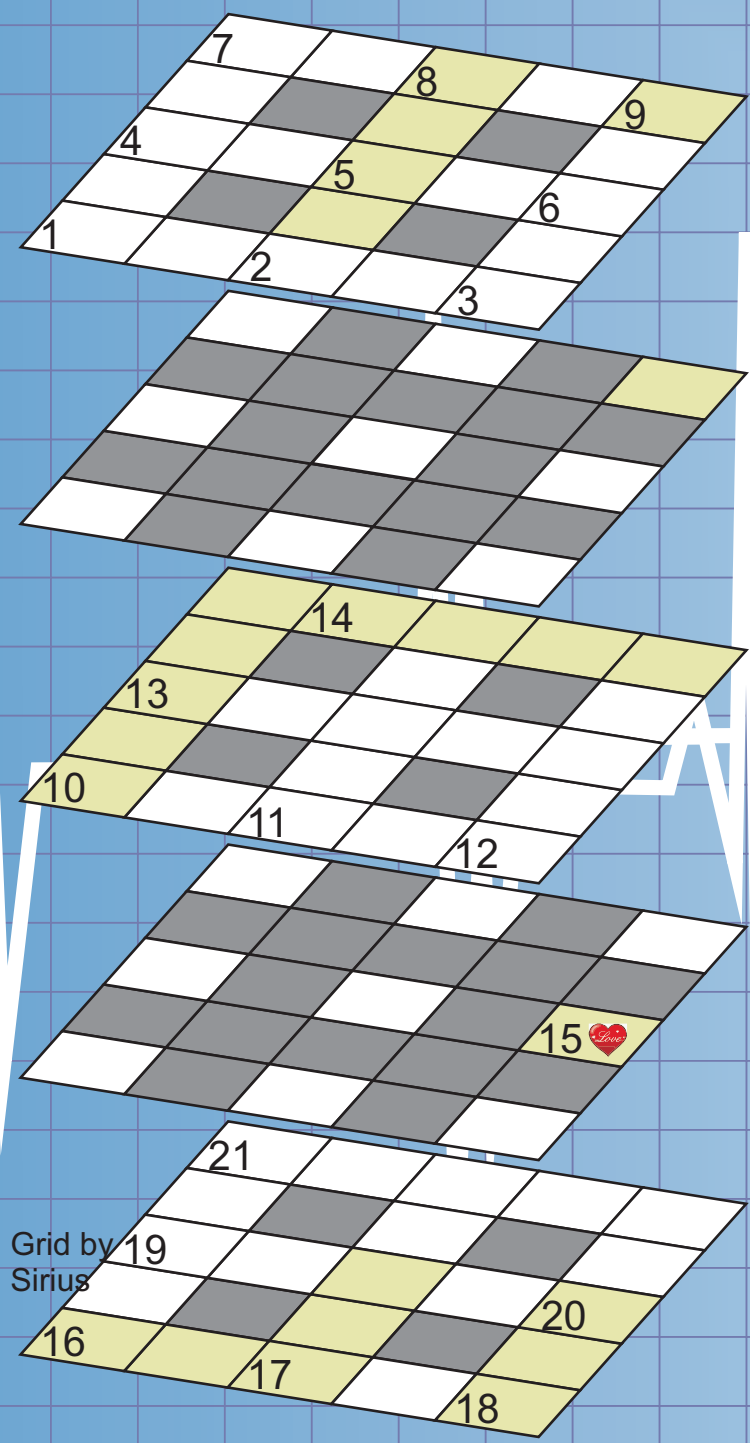


# January 2012 Rufus
