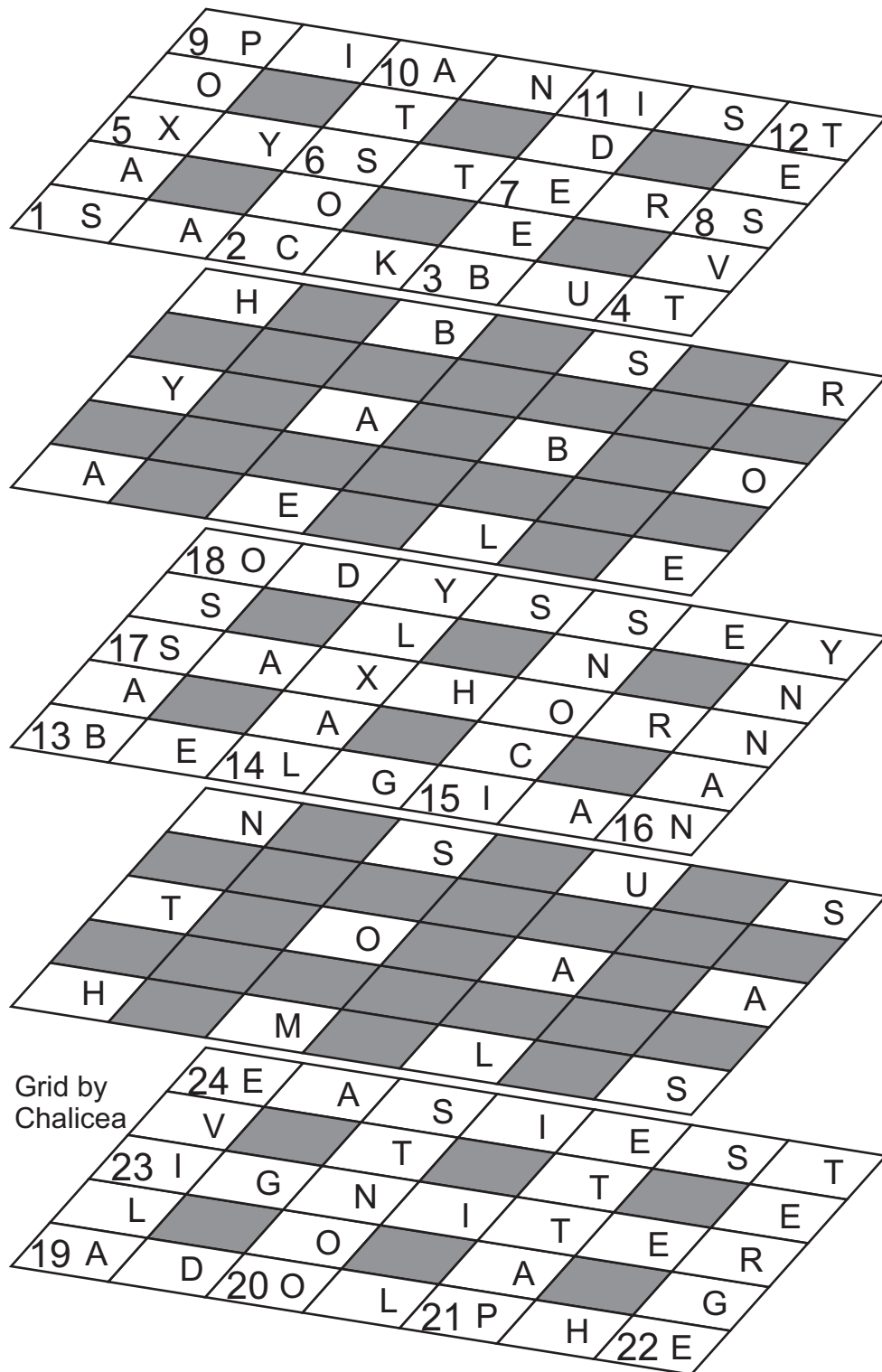


# November 2014 Samuel
