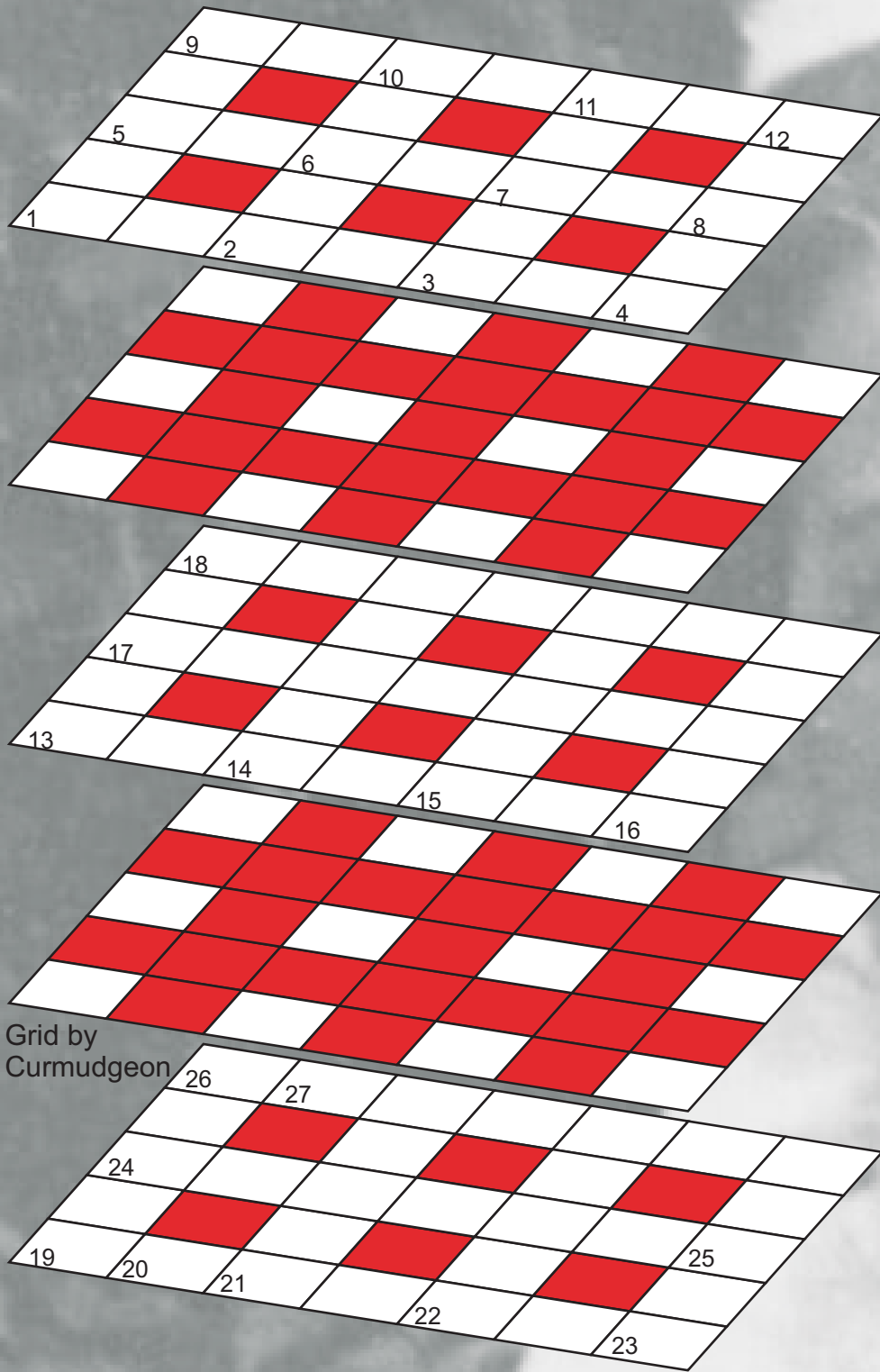


October 2016 Curmudgeon
