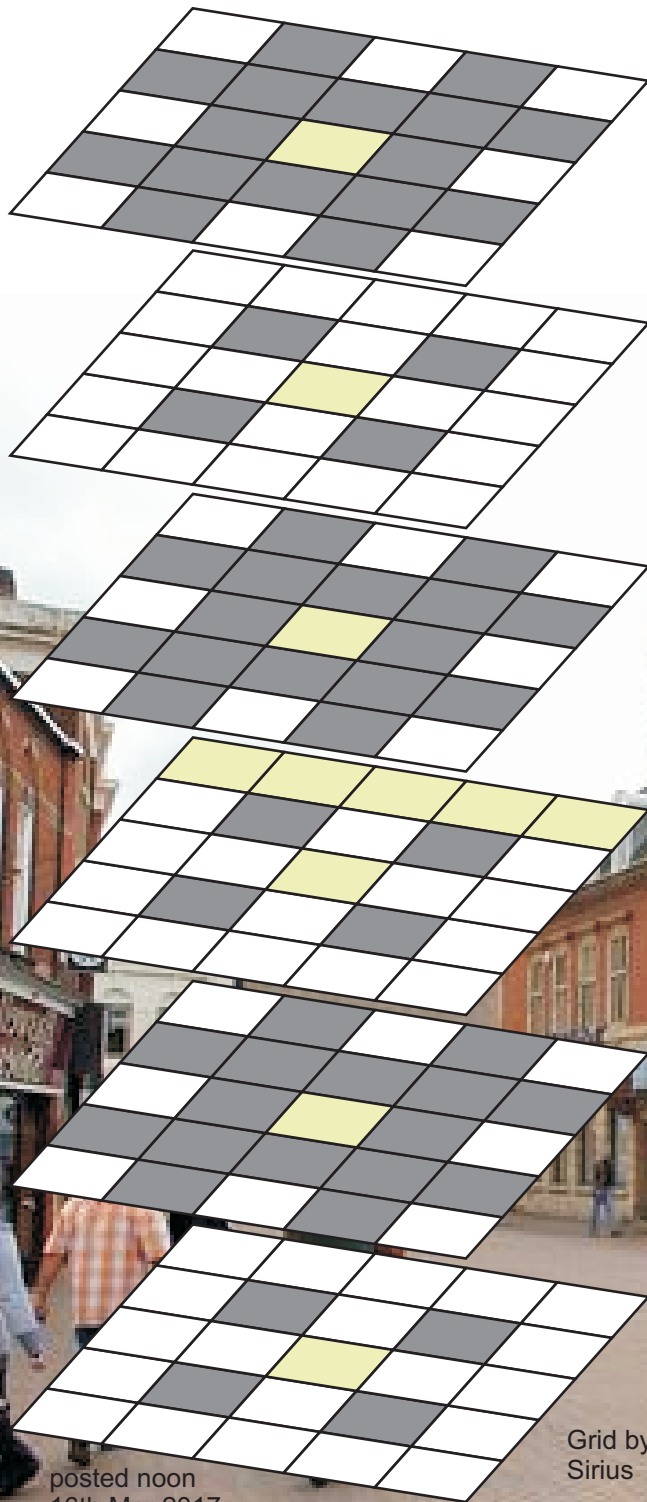


March Extra 2017 Puck Sirius

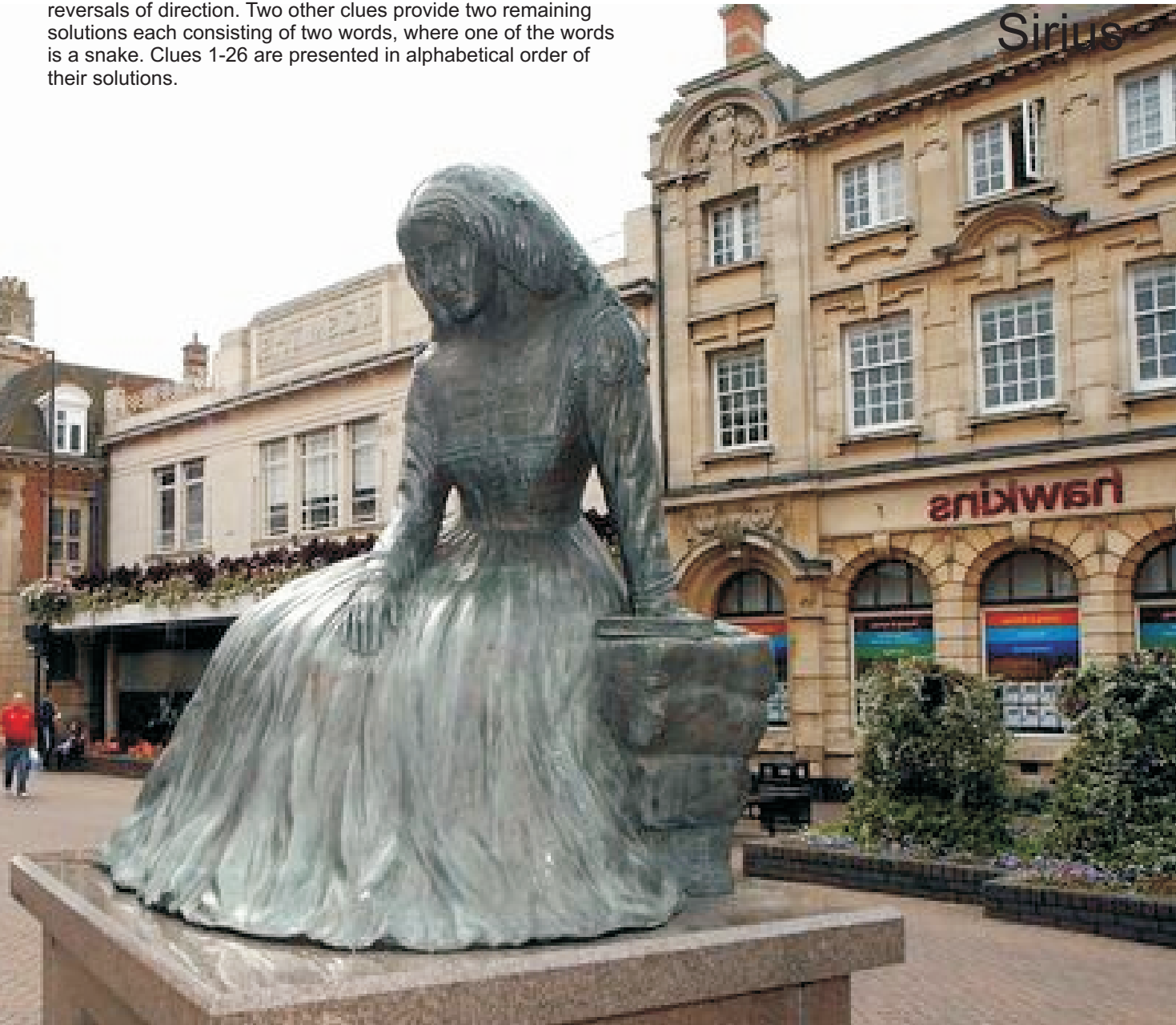
This challenging puzzle is very much of its time. Solve the clues and enter solutions in the grid jigsaw-wise, where they will fit.

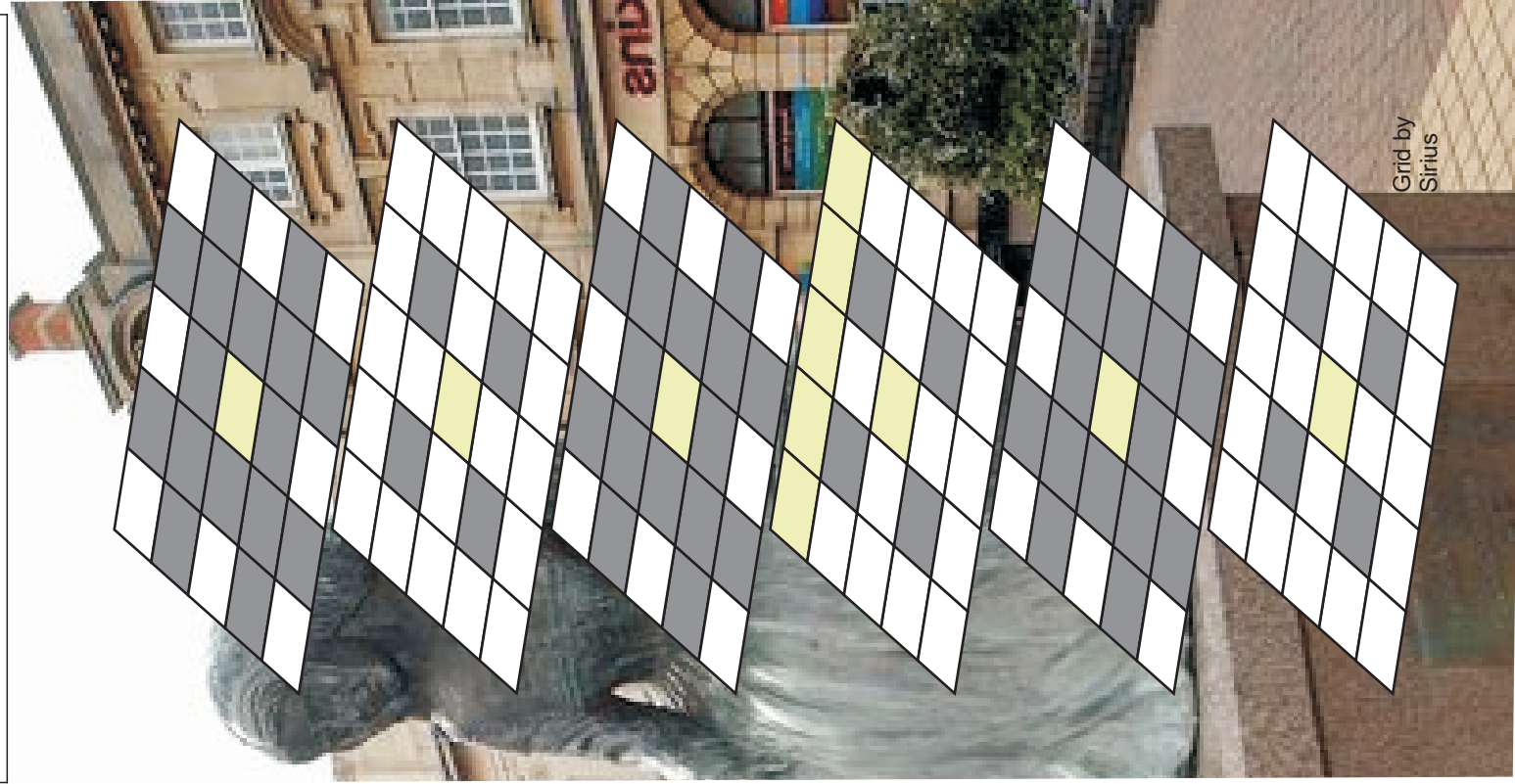
